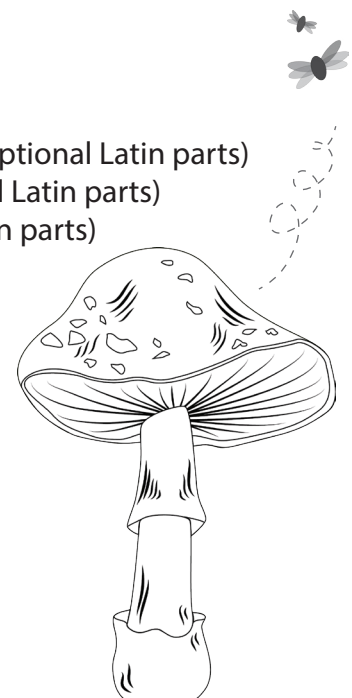
Preview the file before printing to see which pages you would like to print.
This file contains 2 versions of nomenclature cards.

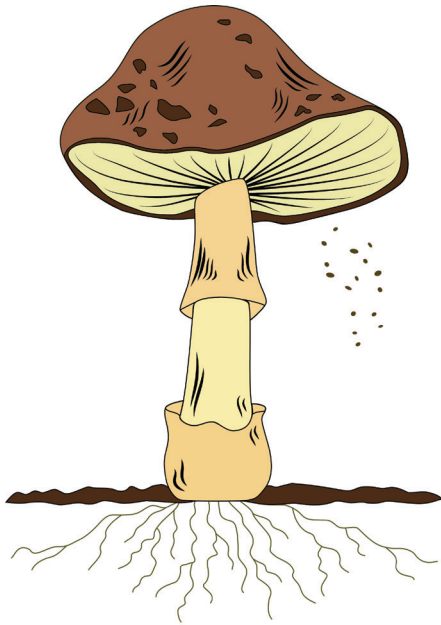
Print the file in colour and make as many copies as you need for your classroom use.

If you print the entire file on a colour printer, the black and white pages are printed in "Rich Black". This means it is a darker and higher contrast black. Regular black and white printing is more grayscale in appearance.

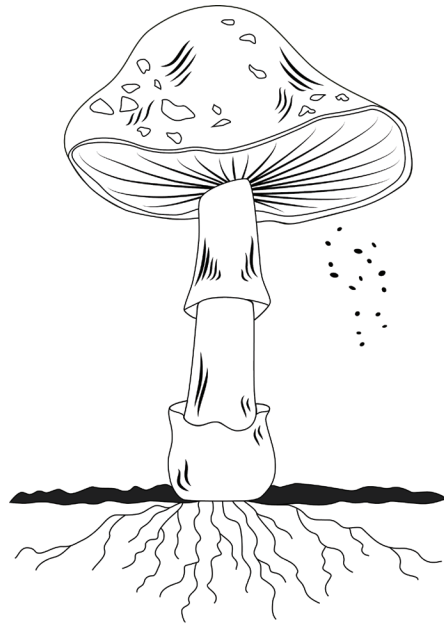

- Mushroom colouring booklet. (Optional labels included)

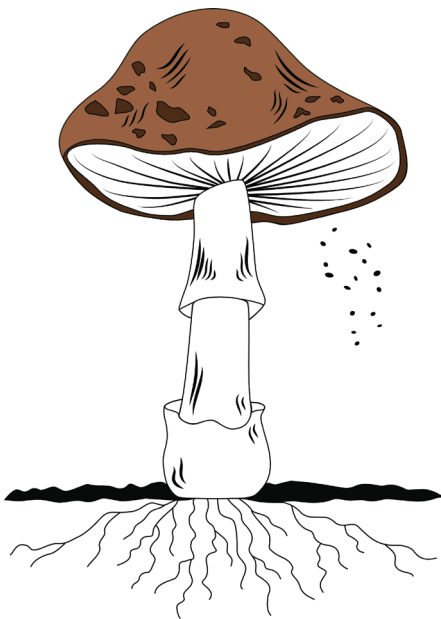




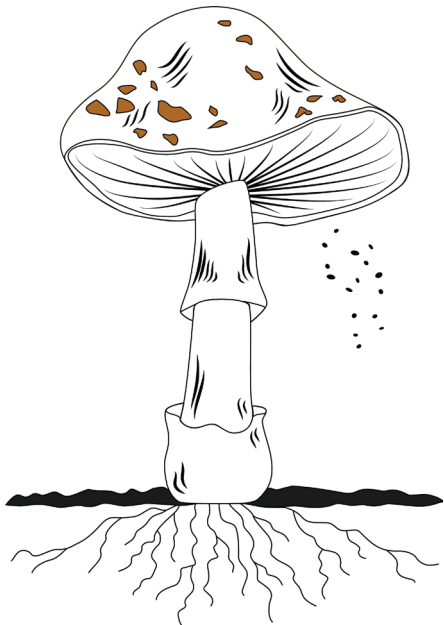

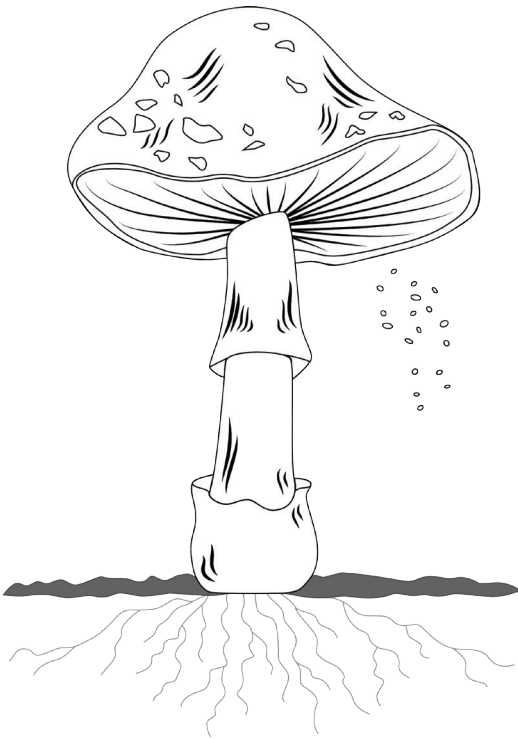
Staple allowance

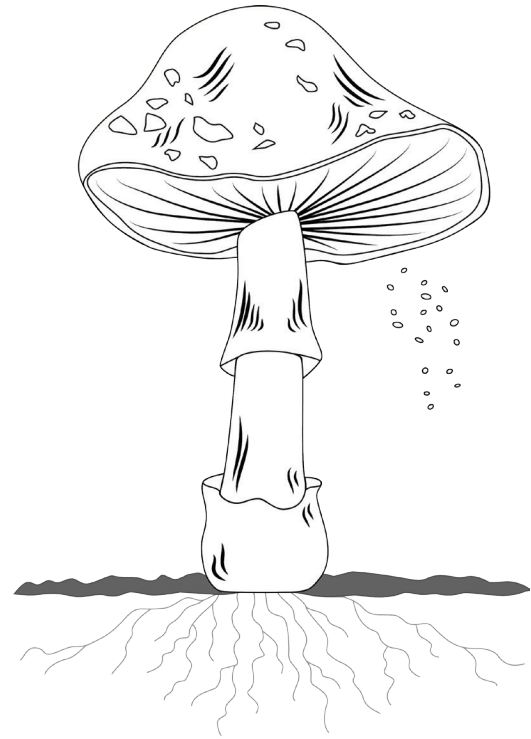


Instructions:

1. Copy as many pages as needed for your classroom use.
2. Cut the booklet pages out along the solid lines. Each sheet makes 2 booklet pages.
3. Do not cut along the dotted lines. They indicate the area that will be covered up when the pages are bound together either by stapling or lacing.
4. Keep all printing and colouring to the right of the dotted line to ensure it will not be concealed under the binding.
5. Alternate image of mushroom top on page 3 can be used for easier colouring of smaller details like the spores.
6. Optional labels can be pasted into pages if a child is not ready for printing yet.

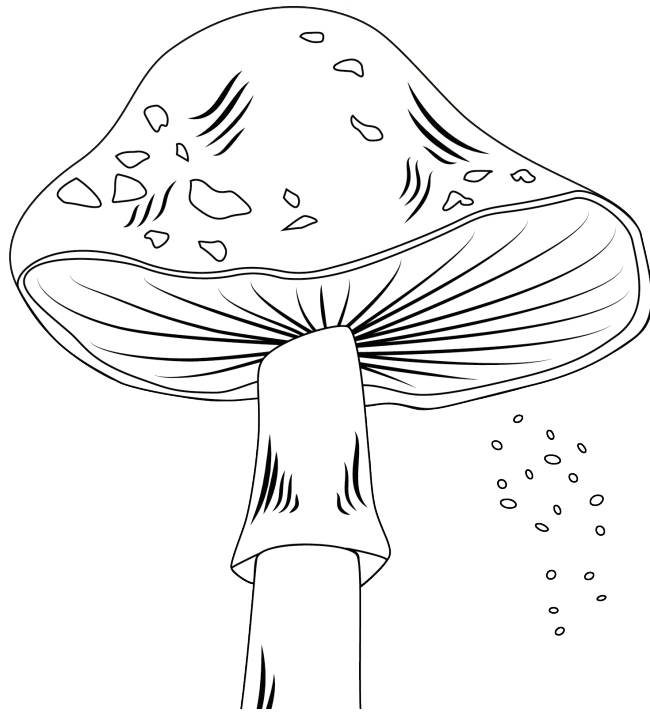

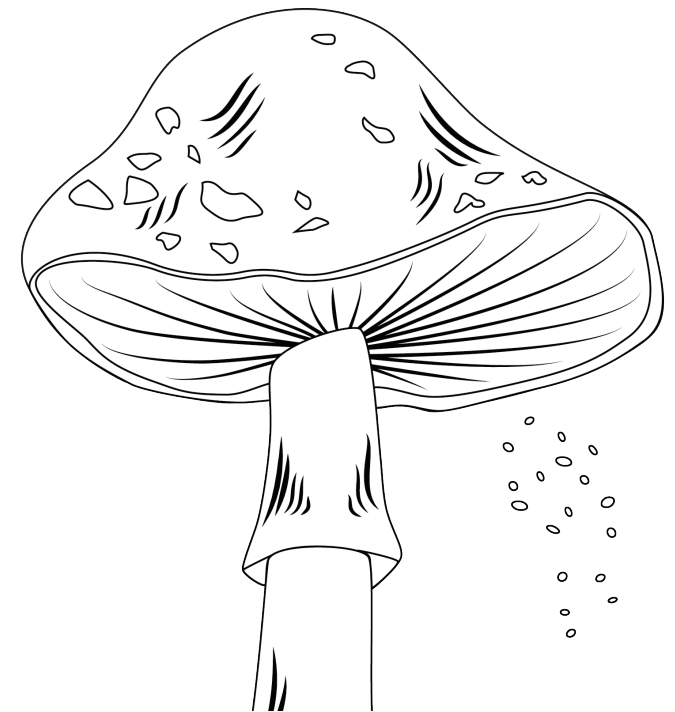
